Exhibit Space Rebate: For companies performing the demonstration in dedicated space in their paid Technical Exhibit booths (“Distributed Demonstration”), RSNA will provide a rebate of \$1525, equivalent to 50% of the 10’ x 10’ space allocated for demonstration purposes (see section 2 of the Terms of Participation below). This rebate will be provided immediately following the RSNA Annual Meeting.

Terms of Participation

The Radiological Society of North America (“Sponsoring Organization”) agrees to organize and host the IHE Demonstration at RSNA 2006, providing necessary facilities and staff, and to publicize the event through communications and marketing materials. By submitting this application/contract, the applying company (“Applicant”) agrees to adhere to the following rules of participation:

1. General

- a. Applicant will take direction from the IHE Technical Project Managers and Sponsoring Organization staff as appropriate throughout the testing and demonstration process. Any applicant failing to comply with directives from the IHE Technical Project Managers and Sponsoring Organization staff may be excluded from further participation in the IHE testing and demonstration process, without any refund of fees.
- b. Applicant will undergo testing preliminary to the demonstration, including an in-person testing event Oct. 9-11, 2006 at RSNA HQ in Oak Brook, IL (“Preliminary Testing Event”), and to submit to the judgment of the IHE Review Committee, composed of representatives from the membership and executive staff of the sponsoring organization, with respect to what constitutes satisfactory testing results. Any applicant failing to complete preliminary testing in the judgment of the Review Committee may be excluded from further participation in the IHE testing and demonstration process, without any refund of fees.
- c. Applicant agrees to promptly correct any violation of the Terms of Participation. Any applicant failing to promptly correct any violation of the Terms of Participation may be excluded from further participation in the IHE testing and demonstration process, without any refund of fees.

2. Application, Fees and Entitlements

- a. **Application:** Applicant must submit this application and contract form by August 15, 2006. The application must include:
 - Indication of the number of systems to be tested and demonstrated, and the composition (IHE Actors and Integration Profiles) of each system. Indication of intention to participate in Distributed Demonstration, Centralized Demonstration or both.
 - Payment in full of the total registration fee (\$4,000), required at the time of application.
 - Names and contact information of technical and marketing representatives. These representatives will be responsible for establishing communication with all parties within the Applicant organization needing to be informed about IHE deadlines, events, policies and other key information.
 - An online registration system will be made available where participants will be able to view and manage information about their demonstration systems. Participants will receive notification about the availability and Internet address of this system.
 - **Fees:** The registration fee will be \$4,000, which includes testing of all systems to be used in the demonstration. Applicant is entitled to participate both in the core demonstration located in the Lakeside Learning Center and in the Distributed Demonstration in Applicant’s own paid technical exhibit booth in the North or South Hall of McCormick Place.
 - **Distributed Demonstration Space Rebate:** For companies participating in the Distributed Demonstration, RSNA will provide a rebate of \$1,525, equivalent to 50% of the 10’ x 10’ space allocation required for this participation, immediately following the RSNA annual meeting. Any such space allocation rebate will be based on satisfactory performance by the Applicant of the Distributed Demonstration in the judgment of the IHE Review Committee.
- b. **Entitlements:**
 - **Testing:** The basic fee (\$4,000) entitles the applicant to test all demonstration systems, each comprising one or more IHE Actors performing applicable Integration Profile(s) listed in the table above. (The terms “IHE Actor” and “Integration Profile,” are defined in vol. I of the IHE Technical Framework.)
 - MESA test tools will be made available to participants for preliminary testing in advance of the Oct. 9-11, 2006, Preliminary Testing Event. Access to these test tools is contingent on participation in the testing process and demonstration. Applicants are forbidden from sharing these tools with outside parties unless and until such tools are released into the public domain by the sponsoring organization.
 - The Preliminary Testing Event, Oct. 9-11, 2006, will afford opportunities for supervised testing among complementary healthcare information and imaging systems. The testing will be structured by a detailed test plan developed by the IHE Technical Project Manager. Successful completion of preliminary testing as defined by this Test Plan in the judgment of the IHE Review Committee is a necessary pre-requisite to participation in the Demonstration.
 - **Participation with Multiple Systems:** Participating companies are invited to test multiple systems at the Oct. 9-11 preparatory testing event and to demonstrate multiple systems at the RSNA Meeting.
 - **Distributed Demonstration:** Participants are encouraged to demonstrate all tested systems in their commercial exhibit booths during the RSNA Annual Meeting.
 - **Centralized Demonstration:** RSNA reserves the right to limit the number of systems demonstrated in the centralized element of the demonstration in order to maintain balance and facilitate communication and an optimal attendee experience. Each participating company wishing to participate in the centralized demonstration will be allowed at least one system in that part of the demonstration. Demonstration of multiple systems by a single participating vendor will be contingent upon the benefit of inclusion of these multiple systems in the judgment of the IHE Review Committee.
 - **Exhibition and Promotional Effort:** Each participating company will be listed in materials describing the Demonstration to be distributed to RSNA membership and meeting attendees in advance of and during the Demonstration via printed publications, signage, multimedia presentations and the Internet.
 - Some of these materials will remain available throughout the 2006 calendar year (approximately) and will be distributed at gatherings sponsored by other relevant medical professional associations.
 - Relevant details (as determined by the IHE Review Committee) of each company’s successful participation, including all IHE Actors and Integration profiles successfully tested, will be highlighted in these educational and promotional materials.
 - At the RSNA annual meeting, these materials will be distributed at points of high visibility and discussed in informational presentations.
